Key Points:	 The frequency of extra-curricular activities (especially music vocal and instrumental) should be more. Circulars for competition to be shared prior to 2 days. Provision of separate clubs (Cultural Activities) for music and dance. Flameless cooking should not be there in Prep class. (Importance of nutrients should be inculcated if following the flameless cooking.) Instead of craft making activity speaking activities (elocution, show 'n' tell and storytelling activity) should be there, sketching and drawing to be given in PREP class. In Sports class Single sport should be taken (as per the individual's choice) for a quarter or year, sports should not be gender based. Application Based Learning should be there. (Students should not cram and write answer, they should be encouraged for writing his/her own answers.) RFID should work up to the mark (follow up call should be there from school's end.) Holidays homework should not be given in festivals' break. Garbage near the school periphery to be eradicated. Students should imbibe a habit of Chanting the Sanskrit shlokas. Motivational talk by the senior students or any well-known personality. Provision of Mic in NUR and PREP during competitions. Timely declaration of result of the Competitions held in school.
