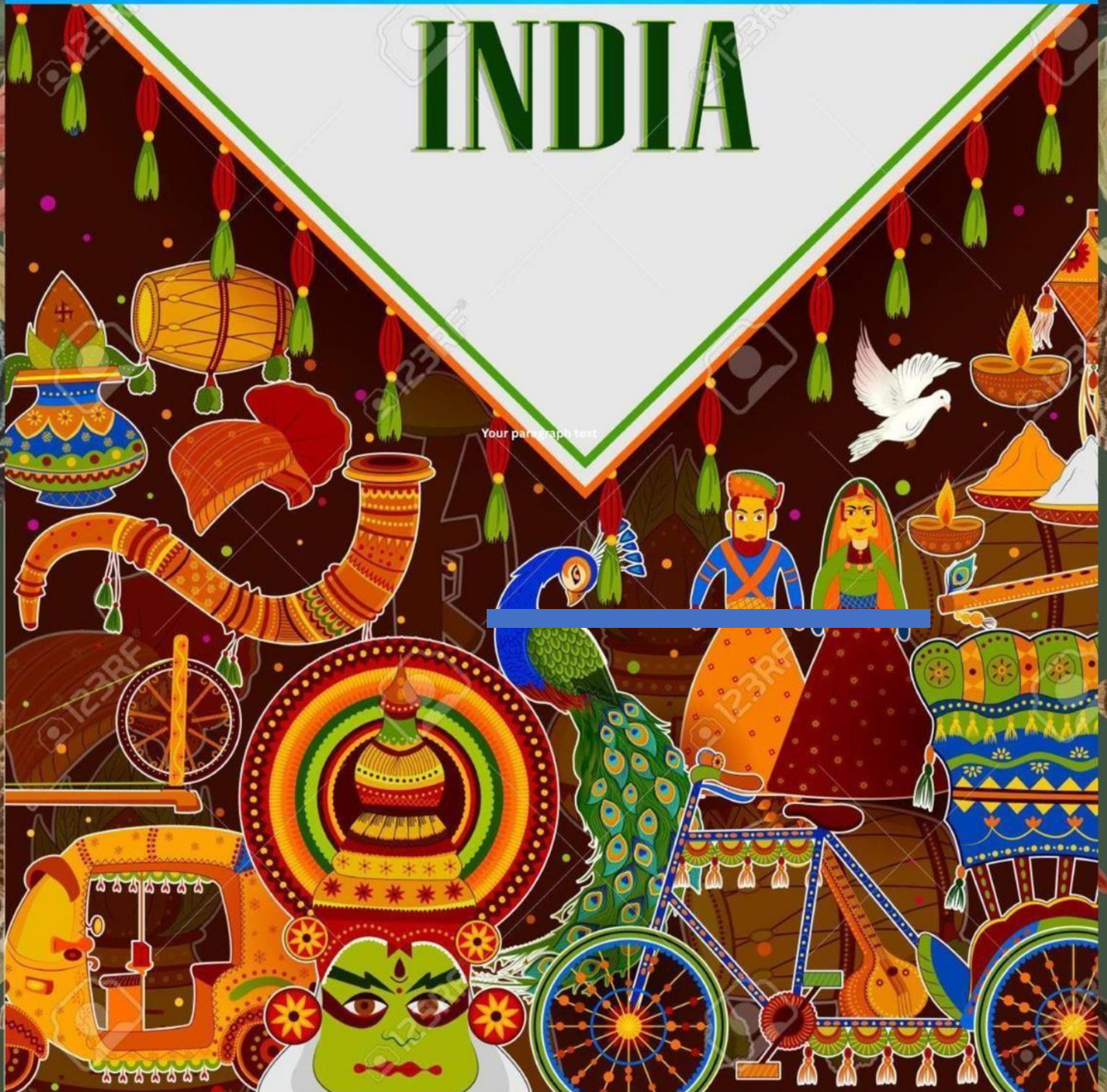

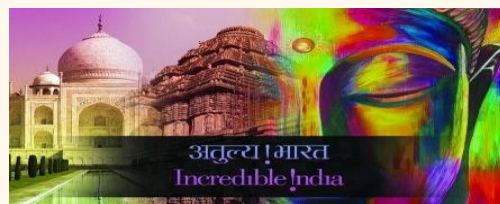
Explore the diversity, culture, and beauty of our country through the theme "**Incredible India.**" Complete the tasks below and be ready to present your learnings after the holidays!

How to Make a Travel Brochure (Step-by-Step)

1. Choose Your Destination

Pick a state, city, or famous tourist place in India (e.g., Rajasthan, Kerala, Agra, Varanasi, Sikkim, etc.).

2. Fold Your Paper (Optional)

Take an A4 sheet or colored sheet and fold it into **three equal parts (tri-fold)** like a pamphlet – or simply use full A4 pages if making a multi-page brochure.

3. Add a Title

On the front panel or top of the page, write:

- **Destination name** (e.g., "Discover Kerala – God's Own Country")
- Add a **catchy slogan** or tagline.
- Decorate with relevant drawings or pasted pictures.
 - **Write Informative Sections**
- Inside the brochure or in different sections/pages, include the following:
 - 🗺️ **Famous Places to Visit**
 - List 3–4 tourist spots with 1–2 line descriptions.
Example: *"Backwaters of Alleppey – peaceful boat rides through palm-lined canals."*
 - 🎉 **Local Festivals & Culture**
 - Mention any major festival or cultural event.
Example: *"Onam – the harvest festival of Kerala, celebrated with flower carpets and boat races."*
 - 🍽️ **Traditional Food**
 - Add 2–3 famous dishes with short descriptions or images.
Example: *"Appam with stew – a popular breakfast dish."*
 - 👕 **Clothing & Lifestyle**
 - Mention traditional dress or customs.

5. Use Visuals

- Paste or draw **pictures** of monuments, food, costumes, festivals, or nature.
- Use **maps, icons, or doodles** for extra appeal.

6. Keep Language Simple & Clear

- Use **short paragraphs or bullet points**.
- Check **grammar, spelling, and punctuation**.

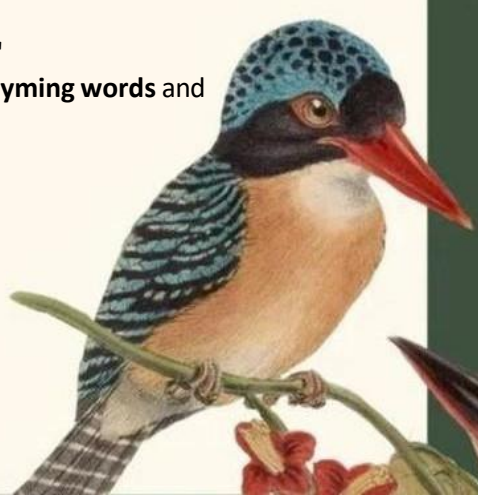
7. Decorate Neatly

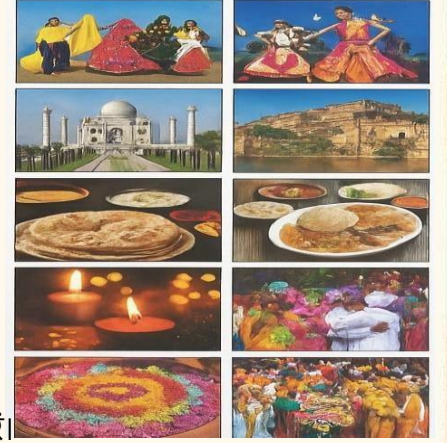

Sanskrit Holiday Homework

1. शब्दरूपाखर् (Shabda Roopani) – Noun Forms

Write the declension (शब्दरूप) of the following words:

- रामः (Rama)
- सीता (Sita)
- फलम् (Phalam) Write all three genders: पुल्लिङ्ग, स्त्रीलिङ्ग,
- and नपुंसकलिङ्ग.

2. धातुरूपाखर् (Dhatu Roopani) – Verb Forms

Write the past tense (लङ् लकार) conjugation of these verbs:

- पठ् (to read)
- ललख् (to write)
- गम् (to go)

3. सुभावषतानन (Subhashitani) – Wise Sayings

Write 5 Sanskrit subhashitas with Hindi meaning. Example:

- ववद्वा ददानत ववनर्ां – Knowledge gives humility.

4. सांस्कृत पररचर् (Sanskrit Parichay – Self-Introduction)

Write a short self-introduction in Sanskrit. Include:

- Your name
- Your age

- Your class
- Your hobbies

(Example: मम नाम आयषः अस्त। अहं सप्तमकक्षायाम् पठालम। ...)
