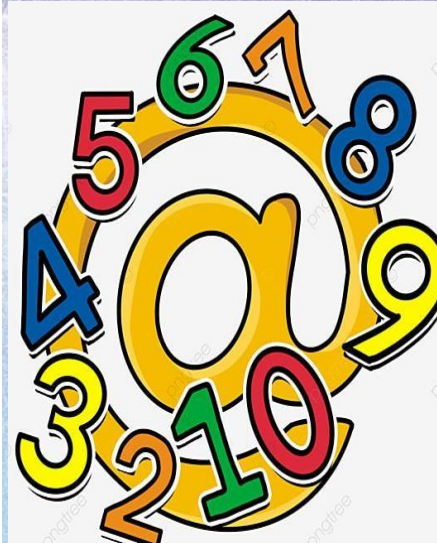

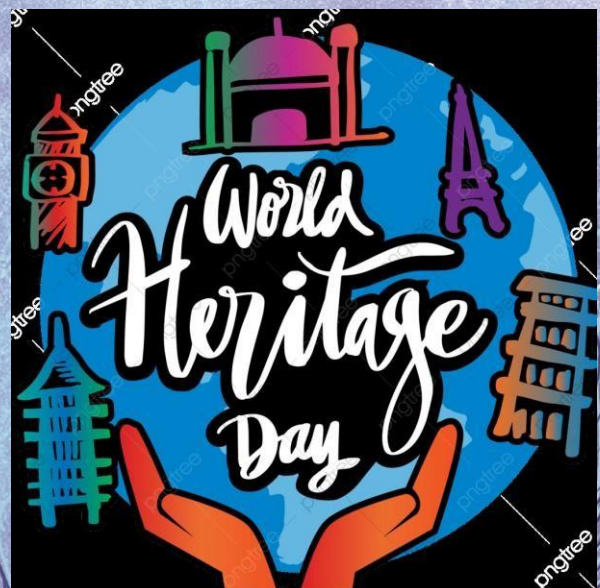




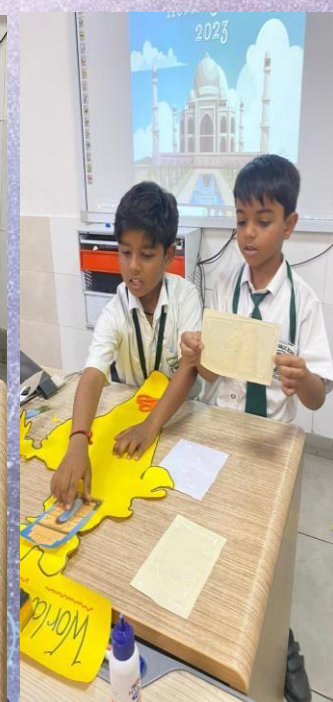
World Heritage Day

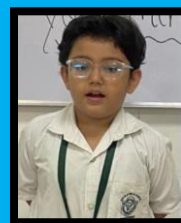

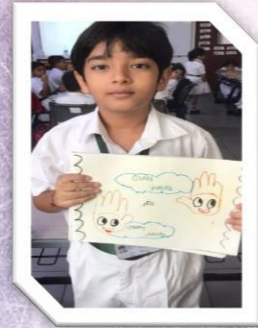
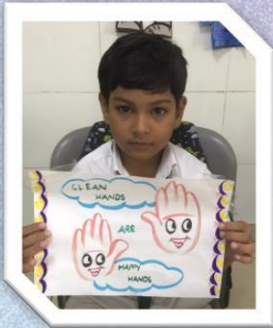

International Yoga day is celebrated worldwide🌐 on 21st June every year.

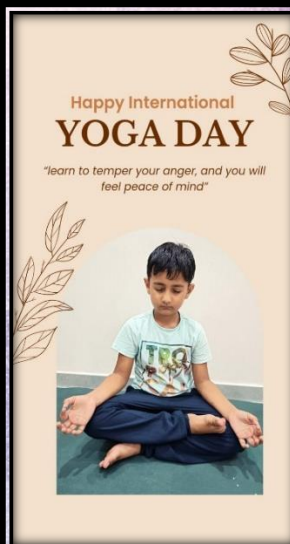
We at DPS encouraged our students to be fit and healthy and students shared the pictures while doing yoga poses at home.
