LABOUR DAY CELEBRATION

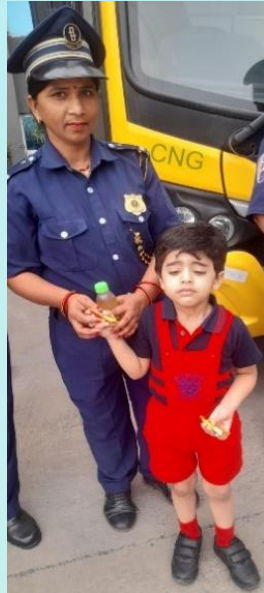
" It is only through labour and painful effort, by grim energy and resolute courage, that we move on to better things."
